Proceeding of the sitting held on 22.05.2018 before Smt Maya Chintamn Ivnate, Hon'ble Member, NCST in the matter of representation of Shri Shri K. Narayana Rao, President, Forum for Social Justice, Guntur along with representations of Shri Kumbha Ravi & Others, Guntur regarding to issue house site pattas.

1. During the sitting, the petitioner, Shri K. Narayana Rao, has raised the grievances of Shri Kumbha Ravi & Others, Scheduled Tribes persons living in Eklavya Colony, Kavuru village, Chilkaluripet Mandal, Guntur District for issuing of house site pattas.

The petitioner has alleged that the Scheduled Tribe person/families are living in Eklavya Colony, Kavuru village, Chilkaluripet Mandal, Guntur since 30 years. But no pattas for house site were issued to them despite making several representations to the District Administration as well as the Govt. At present, they are homeless people.


2. The District Collector, Guntur has submitted a written report and further informed that the matter was enquired through the Tehsildar, Chilkaluripet Mandal. As per his report it is found that the ST petitioners of Eklavya Colony, Kavuru, had made a request to provide house site in Sy. No. 283 with a total extent of Ac. 4.33 cents of Kavuru (V) which is classified as Govt. Land. Out of Ac. 4.33 cents land, Ac. 3.00 cents land is kept vacant and remaining land are in use. It was also brought to the notice of the Revenue Authorities by the machinery of school and local residents that certain extent land was also allocated for playing ground and Govt. have also allocated Ac. 0.03 cents each as well as constructed houses to all the petitioner's parents during the year 1986. At present no land is available to provide house sites. However, after getting suitable land under land Acquisition, the house site pattas will be issued to the resident of the colony.



3. The case was discussed in detail. The Commission observed the Scheduled persons/families are living in Ekalavya Colony for last 30 years and all are

having BPL Ration Cards. Hence, the petitioner's claims for providing pattas for housing site seems to be justified. The District Collector, Guntur has also agreed to provide house pattas to all Scheduled Tribes petitioners after availability of land.

4. The Commission therefore recommends that the District Collector, Guntur may take action to provide house site pattas to all Scheduled Tribe people living in Ekalavya Colony, in Kavuru village and redress the grievances. It may also ensured that no Scheduled Tribe families /persons may evicted from the colony.
5. An action taken report be submitted to the Commission and the case will be reviewed and closed after receipt of the ATR.
