REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE NCST ON THE PENDING CASES CONCERNING GRIEVANCES OF SCHEDULED TRIBES OF DISTRICT PALGHAR (MAHARASHTRA) DISCUSSED DURING THE SITTING UNDERTAKEN BY THE HON'BLE COMMISSION UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF HON'BLE CHAIRPERSON, NCST ON 25.11.2019 AT DISTRICT PALGHAR HEADQUARTER.

Date of Sitting: 25.11.2019

List of officers and petitioners present in the sitting is Annexed.

The National Commission for Scheduled Tribes is a constitutional body set up under Article 338(A) of the Constitution of India to investigate and monitor all matters relating to safeguard provided for Scheduled Tribes under the constitution or under any other law or any order of the Government and to evaluate the working of such safeguards.

As per the Constitutional mandate, the NCST has been receiving a number of representations/complaints on various grievances relating to service, land, atrocity and other matters from the members of the Scheduled Tribes of the District Palghar. In this regard, on receipt of the complaints/representations from the ST members, the Commission initiated an investigation into these matters and also forwarded to the District Administration, Palghar for submission of action taken report. Since, there were no affirmative action taken on the representations referred to the District Administration, therefore, the Hon'ble Commission under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Chairperson, NCST along with Smt. Maya Chintamn Ivate, Hon'ble Member, NCST visited the District Palghar and had held a sitting on 25.11.2019 at District Headquarter (District Palghar) to discuss the pending cases pertaining to harassment and discrimination with STs of District Palghar with the District Administration. During the visit, Shri K. Touthang, Joint Secretary to the Govt. of India, Shri Y.K. Bansal, Research Officer, NCST and Shri Virendra Kumar Jaiswal, PS to Hon'ble Chairperson also accompanied to the Commission. Before the sitting, the Commission also sent a list of the pending individual cases to the District Administration to facilitate the discussion.

2. In the sitting held on 25.11.2019, Dr. Kailas Shinde, District Collector & District Magistrate, Palghar, Shri Gaurav Singh, SP, Palghar, Senior Officers of various Departments of District Administration, Senior Officers from Power Grid Corporation Ltd., Assistant Commissioner, Tribal Welfare, Govt. of Maharashtra, District Thane alongwith concerned petitioners were present.

3. At the outset, Dr. Kailas Shinde, District Collector & District Magistrate, Palghar welcomed the Hon'ble Chairperson, Hon'ble Member and team of the officers of the Commission. Thereafter, the District Collector, Palghar gave a Power Point presentation on the schemes/programmes and welfare activities run by the District Palghar for the development and upliftment of Scheduled Tribes. The presentation revealed about brief details of schemes/programmes implemented for the welfare and development of STs, as well as measures undertaken in the field of education, health, agriculture, employment, literacy, atrocity and providing rights under Forest Right Act etc. In addition, it was reported that the

District Palghar is tribal dominated District which has been notified as Scheduled Area under 5th Schedule of the Constitution on India. The main tribal communities in the District are Warli, Katkari, Malhar Koli and Kokana. All welfare activities of the State and Central Government are being implemented for the development of STs.

4. After power point presentation, the Commission discussed individual pending cases pertaining to grievances of STs in District Palghar. The details of cases discussed and decision taken by the Commission, case wise are as under:

Case No. 1 – Representation dated 31.08.2018 from Shri Devji Shankar Mahali, District Palghar, Maharashtra regarding alienation of tribal land by the non-Scheduled Tribes.

(DSM/14/2018/STGMH/DEOTH/RU-IV)

The petitioner, Shri Devji Sankar Mahali submitted grievances of unauthorized construction and encroachment on the land belonging to STs requesting for restoration of the land in favour of him. In addition, the petitioner also have grievances of Police inaction against co-accused named in the FIR filed under Atrocity Act. He was however stated that as per Commission's recommendation, the SDM, Vasai has decided land ownership issue in the petitioner's favour. But the possession of the land could not be handed over by the District authorities. There was encroachment on the ST land by other non ST people which has not been cleared by the Vasai-Virar Municipal Corporation and local Police authorities. The petitioner also informed the Commission that the party who encroached the ST land, got a stay order from the Hon'ble Court and the District Administration has failed to vacate the stay. Now he is going to file a Writ petition for early hearing to vacate status quo order before the Hon'ble Bombay High Court. He appealed to the Commission that the District Collector, Palghar be directed to vacate the stay order by appointing a Sr. Govt. Pleader to plead the case in the Hon'ble High Court and take immediate action to remove unauthorized construction on ST land.

The District Collector, Palghar apprised the facts of the case and further informed the Commission that the issue of land ownership has been decided by the SDM, Vasai vide his order dated 24.06.2019, cancelling the mutation entry No. 974 and 1012 of survey No. 41, Village-Sativali, Tehsil-Vasai. However, the possession of the land could not be restored in favour of the petitioner due to pending Court cases and obtaining status quo order by the opposition party (non-ST). The matter is listed for hearing in the month of May, 2020. Presently the matter is subjudice. The District Administration is also trying to vacate the stay order for early disposal of the case. Further, the District Administration will take immediate action to appoint a Sr. Government Pleader in the High Court for early vacation of the stay order and restoration of land in favour of the petitioner.

Commission's recommendations – Before deciding the case, the Commission carried out inspection of the said land. They observed that there is illegal encroachment on ST land. Taking into consideration the discussion held and inspection of the site, the Commission recommends the District Collector, Palghar to take immediate action to vacate the status quo order for the tribal land and disposed off the case by engaging Sr. Government Pleader and joining the District Collector, Palghar as party respondent in the Writ Petition No. 6786/2019 filed by non-tribal person M/s Sai Service Pvt. Ltd. in Hon'ble Bombay High Court. All

necessary documents maintained at District in the said land be also provided to the Govt. Pleader. The land be restored to the petitioner. In addition, the District Administration, Municipality authorities and Police authorities will also take necessary action to immediate demolish/remove all encroachment/construction made by the non-tribals on the land belonging to Scheduled Tribes. As per Commission's recommendation, Police action should also be taken against Sai Service Pvt. Ltd., the current encroacher of ST land. The Commission also recommends that the Chief Secretary, Govt. Maharashtra and Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Revenue could see for compliance on recommendations of NCST. The District Collector, Palghar will submit action taken report to the Commission within one month period.

Case No. 2 – Representation received from Shri Raju Pandhara, District-Palghar (Maharashtra) regarding non-payment of rightful compensation to the Adivasi land owners with reference to the land acquisitions made for National Highway No.8 (New National Highway No.48)

(RP/1/2019/MSTR1/DELAAL/RU-IV)

The petitioner informed the Commission that the District Administration had acquired the land of ST farmers in the period between 1960-65 for the Highway and the said land was transferred to NHAI in 2002. However, no compensation for the said land has been paid. The petitioner appealed for rightful compensation to the ST farmers.


The District Collector, Palghar reported that the land was acquired for National Highway No. 8 in public interest and all due payment was made to the affected ST farmers. However, one Shri Pandu Shidva Patil Watan did not collect the amount and the same was deposited in the name of Govt. of India. In addition, no land belonging to Shri Suresh Chaure as named in the representation was acquired. Moreover, the acquisition was made before 60 years and period of raising objection has lapsed. The complainant could now approach the competent court in the matter.

Commission's recommendations – The case was discussed. The Commission advised that the District Collector, Palghar will re-examine the issue and will take necessary action to resolve the petitioner's grievances. At the same time, the concerned petitioners are advised to meet the District Collector and may submit a representation alongwith all requisite documents in the related case for action to be taken by the District Administration.

Case No. 3– Representation of Shri Ashok Kumar, CITU Delhi State Committee Member, New Delhi regarding non-payment of compensation for the land acquired for PGCI transmitter lines.

(AK/1/2017/STGMH/DEOTH/RU-IV)

The Commission was informed by the petitioners that as per the decision taken during the sitting held by the Hon'ble Vice-Chairperson of the Commission on 28.06.2019 at Palghar regarding rectification of disparity in award of compensation and payment of rightful

compensation to the STs after physical verification of the land acquired alongwith compensation for the damage of tree, houses and other articles due to installation of higher voltage of transmission line made by Power Grid Corporation Limited within one month time, no action has been taken by the District Administration so far. The affected STs are still waiting payment of damages and parity in award of compensation.

The District Collector, Palghar informed the Commission that the physical verification of the land and collection of data on damage of trees could not be completed due to heavy workload of Revenue officials. Moreover, the issue of disparity in award of compensation is yet to be examined as there are so many complaints received by the District Administration. However, the physical verification will be completed within three month period and the case will be decided accordingly.

The Officers from PGCIL were also present in the sitting and they apprised the Commission that the decision of the District Collector will be complied with.


Commission's recommendations – The Commission observed that it is a long pending issues wherein the STs have been deprived of their rightful compensation. They are living in fear and they are not able to carry out agriculture activities on the land due to installation of high voltage transmission line. The Commission recommended in the matter that the District Collector, Palghar will complete the physical verification of the land and damage of the trees within one month period. The issue of disparity for awarding compensation especially cases of Shri Jagan Kakadia Burf, Tehsil – Dahanu, Shri Devrang Barakya Lahange and others, Tehsil – Talasari and Shri Dilip Babu Satwi, Tehsil – Dahanu will also be examined and necessary corrective action will be taken accordingly. The issue will be resolved in time bound manner and to submit action taken report to the Commission.

Case No.4 – Representation dated 04.06.2019 received from Shri Shikandar Ekanath Thakare, Assistant Teacher, Santhikumar Adivasi Vidhya Mandir, Varkhanda, Tehsil -Dahanu, Distt. Palghar, Maharashtra regarding denial of promotion.

(SET/2/2019/STMH/SEPROM/RU-IV)

The petitioner raised the grievances of denial of promotion to the post of Head Master despite, having eligibility and being senior most in the cadre.

The District Collector apprised the facts of the case. He further asked the Secretary of the School Institution's Society to submit the action taken in the matter. The Secretary of School Institution reported that the Institution wherein the petitioner is working is minority institution. The institution is exempted from the Maharashtra Employees of Private Schools (Conditions of Service) Regulation Act, 1977. The Institution has its own rules and regulations for recruitment and promotion. The promotion in the Institution is based on merit cum performance. Since, the petitioner's performance is not upto the mark fixed by the Institution, hence, he could not be promoted.

Commission's recommendations – The Commission recommended that the District Collector, Palghar will examine all School records pertaining to issue of promotion of the petitioner and will take corrective action to redress the petitioner's grievances.

Case No. 5– Representation dated 04.06.2019 received from Shri Shikandar Ekanath Thakare, Tehsil – Dahanu, Distt.- Palghar, Maharashtra regarding harassment with ST people.

(SET/6/2019/STGMH/ATOTH/RU-IV)

The petitioner has raised the grievances of harassment and atrocity against STs and police inaction against the accused person.

In this matter, the Commission observed that the petitioner has not filed any report/FIR to the local Police station against accused persons for his harassment. Hence, the petitioner was advised to file an FIR against his harassment with concerned Police Station and the concerned Police officials will take necessary action in the case.


Case No. 6 – Representation dated 29.10.2018 received from Shri Sankar Ramji Karkbar, Palghar, Maharashtra regarding denial of regularization of services of the STs who are working for the last 35 years in the State Level Fruits, Garden and Hospital Agriculture Department, Dapchari Tehsil-Dahanu, District-Palghar, Maharashtra.

(SSK/4/2018/STGMH/SEOTH/RU-IV)

The petitioner has raised the grievances of non regularization of service despite working for the last 35 years in the State Level Fruits, Garden and Hospital Agriculture Department, Dapchari Tehsil-Dahanu, District-Palghar, Maharashtra. All the employees belonging to ST category and Hon'ble High Court of Aurangabad has also given order dated 31.03.2008 for providing regular job to them. This has not been complied with.

The District Collector submitted a report in the matter and also reported that the petitioner's grievances was examined and found that the concerned petitioners have not submitted the requisite documents. Therefore, their grievances could not be resolved. However, on receipt of the documents the case will be considered.

Commission's recommendations – The Commission advised that the petitioner will submit all requisite documents to the District Administration and the District Collector, Palghar will consider the matter and will take necessary corrective action to resolve the petitioner's grievances.

Case No. 7 – Representation dated 29.11.2018 received from Shri Subhash Govind Jhirwala, Seasari (Kamatpada), Palghar, Maharashtra regarding Discrimination and harassment of Scheduled Tribe in the matter of appointment of Teachers.

(SGJ/3/2018/STGMH/SEOTH/RU-IV)

The petitioner has raised the grievances of violation of rules in contractual recruitment of Sports Teacher in Government Ashram School in Palghar District. The appointment is for Scheduled Area ST people. But no local Scheduled Area people has been given appointment.

The District Administration reported that in the rules for appointment of Teachers notified for the Scheduled Areas, there is no mention about appointment of Sport Teachers and Computer Teachers. Moreover, no recruitment Rules for Sport Teacher/Sports Instructor has been prepared. However, as per Government rules, notifications and following due process, 64 Sports Teachers were selected for 64 Govt. Ashram Schools. The appointment is on contractual basis for a specific period. However, the recruitment rules for Sports Teachers are being finalized and local ST people will be considered against permanent posts.

Commission's recommendations – The Commission recommended that the District Collector, Palghar will consider to resolve the petitioner's grievances.

Case No. 8 – Representation of Shri Raju Pandhara, District – Palghar regarding violation of PESA Act, 1996, violation of Constitutional Safeguards for acquisition of ST land w.r.t. ongoing land acquisition in District – Palghar for proposed Mumbai Vadodara Expressway.

(RP/15/2018/STGMH/DEOTH/RU-IV)

The case was discussed in detail. The Commission observed that it is a policy matter. The District Collector, Palghar is advised to refer the matter to the State Government for consideration.

Case No. 9 – Representation of Shri Ramji Maheswari Sanjot, Secretary, World Human Welfare Council, Ulhas Nagar, Mumbai regarding harassment.

(RMS/1/2017/STGMH/ATPHHR/RU-IV)


The petitioner submitted before the Commission that the Police authorities have trapped to the innocent ST persons in murder case of Shri Yadav Janardhan Mahatre in 1987. The innocent ST persons were kept in Police custody for five years. Thereafter, on Hon'ble Court's intervention, the innocent ST persons were released and cleared from all charges. The Police did not take any action to arrest real culprits in the case and also not take any action against the guilty Police officials who kept innocent STs in Police custody. The eye

witness of the case was also harassed. No FIR against the defaulter Police officials under Atrocity Act was filed and arrested. The case was also taken by the Hon'ble Commission and recommended for action against defaulter Police officials and providing compensation to the ST persons. However, no compensation was paid and no action was taken against the defaulter officials.

The SP, Palghar reported that the Police action was done as per rule and no discriminatory role of Police officials in the matter of harassment with ST people was proved in the higher level inquiry. Since, there was no FIR lodged under Atrocity Act and hence no compensation could be given to affected ST persons.

Commission's recommendations – The Commission observed that it is a serious matter wherein the innocent ST people and eye witness were harassed and kept in Police custody for 5 years unnecessarily. No action was taken against guilty Police officials and no compensation was paid to the ST persons and eye witness who made Police complaint. The Commission recommends that the District Collector and SP Palghar will review the matter and take necessary corrective action to resolve the petitioner's grievances within one month period.

At the end of the meeting, the District Collector, Palghar assured the Commission that necessary corrective action will be taken and due relief will be provided to the STs. It will also be ensured that no injustice will be meted out.
