Nagu, Vice President, Akhil Bharatiya Vanvashi Kalyan Ashram, Hyderabad regarding atrocity against 41 Koya Scheduled Tribe families of Seetaigudem Village, Chandrugonda Mandal of KG District, Telangana by the Forest Officials and local Police Officials by way of eviction from the forest land, brutally beaten and damaged cotton crops - action against accused under Atrocity Act.
