### TOUR REPORT OF SHRI ANANTA NAYAK, HON'BLE MEMBER NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES TO SAMBALPUR, ODISHA ON 25<sup>TH</sup> APRIL, 2023

---


The Commission has come across a disturbing news item published in "The Indian Express" dated 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 captioned as "Brawl" led to man's death in Sambalpur, no link to Communal tension: Police". It has been reported that Chandramani Mirdha, a tribal youth has been killed by the miscreants and another person sustained severe injury on the eve of Hanuman Jayanti despite police deployment.

The Commission took Suo Moto Cognizance of the matter and issued notice to Shri Pradeep Kumar Jena, Chief Secretary, Government of Odisha, Shri Sunil Kumar Bansal, Director General of Police, Odisha, Smt Ananya Das, District Magistrate and Collector, Sambalpur and Shri Battula Gangadhar, SP, Sambalpur seeking facts and comments and Action Taken Report within 3 days.

Pursuant to the Notice of the Commission, the SP, Sambalpur furnished a report along with the facts and comments and stated that FIR has already been registered and investigation is underway. The victims in the case are Chandramani Mirdha (ST) and Biswanath Sikka (SC). 11 accused persons have been identified out of which 4 have been arrested so far. The victims in the case are Chandramani Mirdha (ST) and Biswanath Sikka (SC). The provisions of SC/ST Act have been added as well. On the basis of Joint Enquiry Report, the District Welfare Officer, Sambalpur has written to Director (SC Welfare) ST and SC Development Department, Odisha sanctioning monetary relief of 4,62,550 INR and 1,50,000 INR to the family of Chandramani Mirdha(ST) and Biswanath Sikka(SC).

Similar letters have been received from the IG of Police (HRPC) and the District Collector, Sambalpur. The letter of District Welfare Officer dated 22.04.2023 is also attached whereby he has submitted the joint enquiry report to Director (SC Welfare) ST and SC Development Department, Odisha. In the first stage (Filing of FIR), the recommended monetary relief for the family of Chandramani Mirdha (ST) and Biswanath Sikka(SC) is 4,62,550 INR and 1,50,000 INR respectively. In the second stage (filing of Chargesheet), amount of 5,12,500 INR and 3,00,000 INR will be given to the family of Chandramani Mirdha(ST) and Biswanath Sikka(SC). In the third stage (Conviction by the Court), an amount of 50000 INR and 1,50,000 INR is recommended to be given to the families of Chandramani Mirdha (ST) and Biswanath Sikka(SC).

The Commission has gone through the contents of the Complaint of the Inspector in Charge, Dhanupali police station, Sambalpur based on which one F.I.R. has been lodged.

The Commission has also gone through several media reports in between. After going through the documents and the contents of the reports, the Commission decided to make a field visit and ascertain the factual positions of the entire issue.

Shri Ananta Nayak, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes, New Delhi arrived at Jharsuguda at around 08.00 Hours on the 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2023, accompanied by Mr Jayant Sarode, Director, NCST. Mr R.K. Tripathy, Special

Rapporteur, NCST and Mr D.K.Palai, UDC, R.O., Bhubaneswar, NCST proceeded to Sambalpur at around 07.30 a.m. in the morning on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 by road.

**25<sup>th</sup> April, 2023**

As scheduled at about 8.30a.m. Shri Ananta Nayak, Hon'ble Member along with the team of the NCST reached Jhamunda village where the family members of the deceased reside. In the absence of the family members a meeting with the villagers was organised to discuss the death of the tribal youth and other problems. Few villagers turned up to apprise the facts and circumstances to the Hon'ble Member of the Commission.

During the meeting with the villagers some other problems due to inaction and negligence of the district administration. One Balaram Mirdha stated that he has no house under the housing scheme. Another Bishi Mirdha stated that his land has been sold on record illegally. Some other tribal leaders namely Nabin Chandra Mirdha, Tarunjay Dandsena, Panchanan Padhan also expressed serious concern over the lack of benefits under social welfare schemes and forcible, illegal sale purchase of tribal land by the non-tribals and by other communities as well.

Shri Raja Mirdha, a differently able boy who was present in the meeting has also not been duly cared for by the administration. However, the ADM and other officials present there assured that they would take care of the boy by extending the benefits of all welfare schemes as soon as possible.




Hon'ble Member expressed serious displeasure, as the family members of the slain tribal youth could not be made available even in their own native place. Villagers stated that the family has gone to Ganga for final rituals. The administration could not provide the details of the family nor their whereabouts.

The house of the slain tribal youth Chandra is also in a poor condition. His mother and a sister have been approaching the administration for help under welfare schemes but nothing materialised, said a villager with a condition of anonymity.

Whatever it may be the Commission observed that the failure of the district administration resulted in denial of rights after death. The final ritual has been conducted without the tribal folk and the villagers as per tribal customs and traditions. Going to Ganga after few days also is not as per the culture.

The Commission observed that due to the failure of the Police and district Administration Chandra has been killed by the miscreants. The tribal customs, culture and traditions have been violated. The rights after death also could not be ensured. The safety and security of the family members and reach of welfare schemes still remains a question.



I want to draw your attention to the following points after the disturbing incidents of 14th April in which a tribal brother lost his precious life.

- 1) On 14th April ChandramaniMirdha from Jharmunda along with his friend KaliaSikha came to Sambalpur to see Hanuman Jayanti Celebration. While returning back he was murdered by MD Shabir, a resident of Tinabadi & few of his friends at Tinabadi, without any provocation. M.D. Shabir got absconding as he is in the political asylum of Mr. Siddharth Shah (Sidhu), a BJD party worker & local goon; the 3-4 innocent Muslim boys who have been arrested for the murder; they also belong to the same political group.
- 2) When the dead body was brought to The District Head Quarter Hospital by Administration, the Collector & DM herself told the Duty Sister to suppress the case (Mamlarafadafa) by not registering a MLC; but hats off to the Sister who put duty above all such pressure & referred that post mortem is a must.
- 3) Siddharth Shah himself met the victim's family and gave them one lakh twenty thousand rupees & assured them to get ten lakhs from State Government if they maintained their silence on the murder & not file a case. Surprisingly the State Government declared support of eight lakh rupees to the family within a day after recommendation of Mr. Sidhu.
- 4) Before the visit of NCST commission the family was pressurized by Police & Administration in late night hours to keep mum or to bear consequences. Harassed by Police & Administration the victim's old mother & sister had no way out but hide in a relative's house; so they could not meet the commission.
- 5) The victim's friend Mr. KaliaSikha of Bhawanipali, who escaped near death situation in this brutal attack, but lost his fingers is the only eye witness & his life is in grave danger. Before the NCST visit he was attempted to be taken hostage in the dead of night by the Administration. The Sub collector, BDO, Tahasildar, IIC with Police Force went to his village to take him in custody; but luckily the villagers protested & took him out of the police vehicle. They guarded him all night so he could state his tragedy to the commission. This incident is known to all media also.
- 6) The son of Mr. Jehangir, a police Constable, Special Intelligence Cell was part of the Stone Pelting team, his video is present throwing stones from his own home in Bhutapara area at the procession, he is absconding since 12th night. Since last 17 years Mr. Jehangir is posted in Sambalpur without any transfer.
- 7) There is also alarming incidents of Tribal lands being encroached by Muslim people in Sambalpur township who have forcefully snatched these lands by threatening the simple land owners to sign lease agreements & built illegal constructions on them which have become the centre of anti social activity.

- 8) Many refugees & infiltrators are remaining about town who are residing in the Muslim populated areas & most of these people were participants of the stone pelting incident which occurred on 12.4.23. 9.
- 9) Every day 150-200 cows are illegally slaughtered in an area just 200 meters away from Police Station. Why the Police is protecting them?
- 10) Many innocent Tribals have been arrested without any cause following the incident & they are not being granted bail. We Tribals are in an atmosphere of constant fear & terror. That's why I am writing this letter anonymously so my life is not endangered.

Hope you take serious action on this

Hon'ble Member of the Commission left for meeting another youth Mr Kalia Sika, who has been injured in the incident. Although he belongs to SC Community but he was a close friend of the slain tribal youth, Chandra Mirdha. Both of them were treated in the same hospital.






While talking to him he narrated the incident of attack. Crying severely and inconsolably he explained the sorry state of affairs. He was attacked near Daleipada. They were on a bike rally on Hanuman Jayanti. He lost his middle finger and other injuries. He also explained how he and others were attacked during the rally. He also stated it was frightening to see how Chandra Mirdha was attacked and his dead body put before him while he himself was undergoing treatment. His blood stained shirt also was not taken by police for further criminal action. The Commission after witnessing the blood stained shirt of the injured youth realised the lackadaisical attitude of the Police and targeting the marginalised people from SC ST Community in the entire scenario.

He said he was also lifted to somewhere else but due to the intervention of one Lady Activist and elected representative Ms. Sasmitarani Dehury. Her sincere efforts could keep him alive. He further stated that he belongs to landless category. He has either been allured or threatened (by both the methods) to keep silence and not to open mouth before the Commission or before any other Authority.

During the visit it has been observed that even if certain steps have been taken by the district administration but the precious life of the tribal youth has been lost and his right after death has been violated. Other Tribals have also been put behind the Bar. Had the administration taken adequate steps, intelligence inputs such a situation could have been avoided.

#### **Recommendations -**

1. Detailed report on the incidents has to be submitted for further perusal of the Commission.
2. Action Taken Reports with status of investigation along with the copies of all the FIRs during the violence.
3. Protection to be ensured to the slain and injured and affected families.
4. The district administration must take pro-active steps on the issue of Tribal Land alienation especially in the violence hit areas and in the entire district as a measure to ensure tribal land rights.
5. The illegal immigrants and other anti-social elements must be kept under surveillance and appropriate legal action must be ensured against them.
6. The details of influx of illegal immigrants, outsiders settled in the Sambalpur township without required legal formalities for the last five years be submitted for the perusal of the Commission.
7. Appropriate legal aid as per the choice of the accused Tribals must be provided by the State for fair trial.
8. Remaining compensation amount and benefits of welfare schemes has to be ensured to the affected tribal families.
9. Protection to be ensured to the witnessed in the interest of justice.

Sub: Save Sambalpur from communal disharmony and Muslim Tushtikaran


Esteemed Sir,

We, the aware Intellectuals of Sambalpur witnessed and struggled from the piteous and chaos condition in Sambalpur when a lot of Muslim stone pelters pelted heavy stones to the peaceful and auspicious rally of Hanuman Jayanti on 12 April 2023 and 14 April 2023 repeatedly where so many of Hindu devotees and volunteers were seriously injured and threatened to death by the Muslim miscreants. Here, the president of Hanuman Jayanti Organizing Committee was admitted to ICU for getting severe head injury by the fearless Muslim stone pelters. One Dalit devotee brother Mr Mirdha was brutally assassinated with sharp weapons by the Muslim miscreants in the evening of 14 April 2023 in the presence of 42 platoons of police in the city.

Whereas, the Muslim miscreants are moving freely but so many innocent Hindu devotees are surprisingly arrested by the local administration to suppress and pressurize the Hindu victim community. The local and the state administration expressed a passive approach to arrest the real culprits to establish fear in Sambalpur against any Hindu Procession in future. No Hindu community ever objected nor pelted any stone to the Muslim Processions till date. Don't we have rights to march peaceful processions in our auspicious days?

Expecting your sincere and quick intervention in this regard for a fare and square justice.

**Sub - Request to issue an advisory to state govt for proper inquiry into the Sambalpur violence on 12th & 14th April 23 and Brutal killing of tribal boy Sri Chandramani Mirdha.**

**Honourable Sir,**

Sambalpur being the Cultural epic-centre of Western Odisha, observe several religious functions where lakhs of people from the town and surrounding area participate every year. Hanuman Jayanti is celebrated here with devotion every year. As a regular tradition, a procession was arranged around the town this year as per the decision of the Hanuman Jayanti Samanaya samiti. The route of procession was finalized after discussion with the local administration. On the 12th April (Ram Navami) a bike rally was organised by the Samitti on the agreed route with police protection. The rally was attacked at Motijharan by anti-socials of the Muslim community They pelted stones and physically assaulted the devotees participating in the procession/ Sobha Yatra. They injured several bike riders and police personnel and a number of vehicles were brunt.

Though the S.P. Sambalpur and other police officers have mentioned that attack as a pre-planned activity, No visible action was taken against the culprits. That's why, on 14th April when the peaceful procession was going on the occasion of Hanuman Jayanti, large scale vandalism, burning and looting of shops in different places in the town were carried out by the miscreants of the same community. The attack was completely unprovoked and one-sided.

Again, On the same day (14th April) evening a group of the miscreants from the same community pelted stones at two innocent tribal boys who were returning to home near Dalaipada ring road. As both of them fell down from the bike, they were attacked by sharp weapons causing death of Chandramani Mirdha, Age 30, a native of Jharmunda village under Burla police station and severely injuring Biswajit Sikha at Bhabanipali who is undergoing treatment at VIMSAR Medical College Hospital Burla in a critical condition.

The body of tribal youth (Chandramani Mirdha), was hurriedly taken for post-mortem and immediately, the funeral was conducted in the late night without allowing all his relatives and villagers to attend the funeral, "against the custom and traditions of their tribal community to which he belonged.

In spite of a previous warning of the violent situation and attack on the bike rally on 12th, neither the district administration nor the state administration has taken any strong steps against the culprits and miscreants to prevent any further disturbance on 14th April

due to appeasement policy towards the specific community. That is the sole reason for increased violent attack on peaceful Hanuman Jayanti rally / Sobha Jatra on 14th April. After relaxation of curfew the union minister of state of Tribal Affairs Sri Biseswar Tudu and the local MP and MLA are restricted from visiting the family of the deceased tribal boy and severely injured persons at the hospital. This shows the State Government's apathy towards the riot victims especially towards the tribals, for whom we are very much concerned.

**Sub - Request to issue an advisory to state govt for proper inquiry into the Sambalpur violence on 12th & 14th April 23 and Brutal killing of tribal boy Sri Chandramani Mirdha.**

**Honourable Sir ,**

Sambalpur being the Cultural epic-centre of Western Odisha, observe several religious functions where lakhs of people from the town and surrounding area participate every year. Hanuman Jayanti is celebrated here with devotion every year. As a regular tradition, a procession was arranged around the town this year as per the decision of the Hanuman Jayanti Samanaya samiti. The route of procession was finalized after discussion with the local administration. On the 12th April (Ram Navami) a bike rally was organised by the Samitti on the agreed route with police protection. The rally was attacked at Motijharan by anti-socials of the Muslim community They pelted stones and physically assaulted the devotees participating in the procession/ Sobha Yatra. They injured several bike riders and police personnel and a number of vehicles were brunt.

Though the S.P. Sambalpur and other police officers have mentioned that attack as a pre-planned activity, No visible action was taken against the culprits . That's why, on 14th April when the peaceful procession was going on the occasion of Hanuman Jayanti, large scale vandalism , burning and looting of shops in different places in the town were carried out by the miscreants of the same community . The attack was completely unprovoked and one-sided.

Again, On the same day (14th April) evening a group of the miscreants from the same community pelted stones at two innocent tribal boys who were returning to home near Dalaipada ring road. As both of them fell down from the bike, they were attacked by sharp weapons causing death of Chandramani Mirdha Age, 30, a native of Jharmunda village under Burla police station and severely injuring Biswajit Sikha at Bhabanipali who is undergoing treatment at VIMSAR Medical College Hospital Burla in a critical condition .

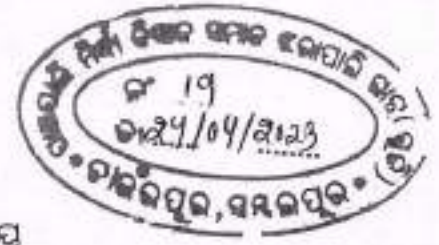

Respected Sir,

We the tribal community of Sambalpur would like to aprise you the following fact for you favour consideration and necessary action regarding the tribal brutal murder of a tribal youth Chandramani Mirddha S/o – Late Satya Kumar Mirddha aged about 32 years resident of Jharmunda, Chaunrpur Dist – Sambalpur on Dt 14.04.2023 at about 8pm .

That on the said date deceased Late Chandramani Mirddha along with his friend came to Sambalpur for witnessing "Hanuman Janmostav" while going back to his village a group of Muslim attacked in the Ring Road, near Batamangala Gali, Daleipada. They brutally murdered Chandramani Mirddha on the spot and physically injured to his friend.

After the incident happened the Sambalpur Administration has shifted the dead body to VIMSAR Burla for postmortem. There after going out of the way the district administration with out handing over the dead body to the member of the family or relatives cremated the dead body in the Rajghat (Cremation ground)of Sambalpur. Even the widow mother of the deceased was not allowed to see the face of her dead son for the last time. More over neither the family members nor the relatives were allowed to do the last right of their dear one as per the traditional rituals and religious believe of the community. Such act of the district administration hurt the religious sentiment of the widow mother, family members, relatives and members of the community which put them in a state of dip sorrow and grief.

It is pertinent to mention you that the role of the district administration is suspicious in handling the case in the way of arresting the culprits, gathering the evidences rather they tried to suppress the fact and influencing the witness in contrasy to discharging their duties vested upon to them by our constitution.

Under the aforesaid circumstance we the undersigned urged before you that this case needs your intervention, attention and proactive action to surface out the malafide intention of the administration and exemplary punishment to the murderer on order to protect the dignity and constitutional right of the tribal youth Late Chandramani Mirddha.
