No 850, Dwarka, District Court, New Delhi-110075 remiss of official duty by Mr. Romil Bhanja, DCP, South-East District, Sarita Vihar police station, New Delhi.

A Representation dated 24/12/2016 received from Shri P. Brahma, Advocate & Social activist, Lawyers ch. No 850, Dwarka, District Court, New Delhi-110075 regarding providing relief amount to the mother of diseased Mrs. Beauty Basumatary as per provision of SC/ST PoA Act, 1989 by the Department of Welfare of SC & ST, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

Matter was taken up with the Commissioner of Police, Delhi Police vide this Commission's letters dated 03/02/2017, 14/03/2017 and 30/06/2017. In response to the above letters of the Commission, no Action Taken Report was received from the Delhi Police therefore, Shri H. K. Damor, Hon'ble Member, NCST has fixed a sitting with the Delhi Police for discuss the matter on 03/10/2017 at 2:30 P.M.

Discussion:

Shri Hareshwar V. Swami, Additional DCP II, South East District and Shri Sanjay Bhardwaj, Inspector / SHO, Govindpuri, New Delhi appeared before the Commission on 03/10/2017. Shri P. Brahma, Advocate also were present in the sitting. The matter was discussed in detail.

The Hon'ble Member asked the DCP to apprise the case. The DCP informed the Commission that the case FIR No. 769/2014, u/s 302 IPC, PS Govindpuri, New Delhi has already been registered. Caste certificate produced by Shri P. Brahma (Advocate of Claimant) has been verified from the Office of the All India Assam Tribal Sangh through ASI Devanand, No. 696/SE, PS Govindpuri who visited the said office of AIATS (Assam) and reportedly found genuine and authentic. As per the verified caste certificate, the claimant belongs to Scheduled Tribe from the caste BOROO KACHARI.

The Commission advised the Delhi Police that supplementary FIR may be lodged under SC/ST PoA Act, 1989. Thereafter, copies of all papers (FIRs, charge-sheet etc.) may be forwarded to the Secretary, Department for the Welfare SC/ST/OBC, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, B-Block, Vikas Bhawan, I.P. Estate, New Delhi for providing victim compensation as provided in the rules framed under PoA Act to the immediate dependents of the victim.
